



Building Futures – Information Sheet

Below is detailed information on the Building Futures program and guidelines for applications.

Building Futures is an initiative that funds sport to:

- Provide sporting opportunities to youth.
- Build skills and capacity in local players.
- Bring communities together to support local players.
- Deliver ongoing benefits to players.
- Support diverse and inclusive needs.

Building Futures does not fund:

- Individuals or organisations that are not eligible recipients.
- Players outside of the Warwick area.
- Requests for capital works or large equipment requiring ongoing maintenance.
- On-going running costs including insurance, employee salaries or overheads.
- Untied cash donations including prize money.

To apply for Building Futures, you must:

- Meet all eligibility criteria.
- Provide a nominated contact/representative of the person applying.
- Complete the application form provided on the Aleva Estate webpage.
- Submit your application prior to the closing date.

To be eligible to apply for Building Futures, your player or club must:

- Play in the local Warwick government area.
- Involve children between the ages of 5-16.
- Be able to supply all information required by the application process.
- Provide proof of playing and legitimacy if required.

We cannot consider your application if you do not satisfy all the eligibility criteria.

Building Futures defines youth sport eligible for donation as people between the ages of 5 and 16 years old.

Applications for the initiative will be open from 1 September 2021 to 30 September 2021. The winners will be announced on 29 October 2021.



The winner of the program will receive a donation of \$5000. There will also be a second-place prize of \$2000 and a third-place prize of \$1000 available.

Applications will be assessed by the appointed committee against application guidelines and recommendations will be made for funding.

We regret that we are unable to provide feedback on individual applications.

Application Guidelines

- Provides a sporting opportunity to local youth.

- Supports diversity and inclusivity.
- Completed all information on application form.
- Initiative has a positive impact on the player.
- Provides plan for use of donation money.
- Addresses local player needs.
